

**Racquet Club Meeting
Meeting Minutes 9/8/2021**

APPROVED

Bob James opened the meeting with a self-introduction as the Club's new Acting President and provided some interesting visuals and tidbits from his past (decorum does not permit including the details in these minutes).

Meeting called to order at 4:39PM by Bob James, Acting President. Minutes of the prior Club Meeting were approved by acclamation (Motion: Tom Vaccaro Second: Lois Green).

Sid Saltzman, Treasurer, provided the Financial Report that included an August balance of \$7,699.70.

Sports Committee Reports:

- Tennis (Patty Coffey) – reports that the backboards will be available “soon” and that the electrical outlets used for the ball machine on courts 8 and 9 are working well (but the GCFI breaker is tripped easily – try hitting the reset button before reporting a maintenance issue)
- Paddle Tennis (Dannica Wood) – drop-in is held every Monday from 9 – 11 and consistently attracts 12 – 14 players. New players are invited – lessons and equipment are provided.
- Badminton (Cliff Singh) – good attendance through the summer with 14 – 18 people at each session. Looking into new dates/times to have equipment set up for additional playing opportunities
- Pickleball (David Johnson) – introduced the new Pickleball Committee (Harvey Bernstein, Sue Bixler, Roxanne Dillon, Suzanne Forman, Sandy Reinhardt), announced the revised/simplified drop-in schedule for the Fall, reminded members that pickleballs in the tubes are a community resource, announced details of the first post-COVID pickleball tournament to be held on October 21st.

David Johnson, Secretary coordinated voting on the changes in the Bylaws and Charter that had previously been approved by the Board and been made available for member review prior to the meeting. There were no objections or discussion from the members – both items were approved by voice vote.

Ann Rike, Vice President announced that Joanne Goglia and Karen Burke would join the Nominating Committee seeking Board members for 2022.

Bob James reminded members that we have two first aid kits available near the courts (one at the HOA near the restrooms and one at the Clubhouse in the Kitchen)

Bob James acknowledged the following members for their contributions to player education over the summer. Beginner Lessons: Herb & Gerry Livsey, Mike Hoggatt, and the many volunteer coaches and support staff. Advanced Lessons: David Levine and Brett Anderson.

Bob James invited all members to support numerous OHCC residents that were competing for medals in pickleball at the upcoming California Senior Games.

Laura Urban and Pele Pyle (Social Chairs) solicited member input on the Winter Party (date still TBD at this time) for a theme and format.

Bob James announced that any new members signing up on or after October 1, 2021 would be considered fully-paid members for all of 2022.
